Driving Directions (See page 3 for map with directions)

DO NOT USE GOOGLE MAPS OR GPS! Strathcona Mine Road is private property and is not properly mapped by commercial mapping software. Use the provided drawn and written directions:

- Take Hwy. 144 passed Chelmsford and Dowling.
 - Turn right onto Regional Road 8 (Levack-Onaping) and continue for 2.5 km.
 - Drive through the Sudbury Integrated Nickel Operations Gate (on the right) and continue down Strathcona Mine Road for 6 km (follow signs for "NORCAT Training Centre").
 - Turn right at NORCAT Underground Centre/Fecunis Adit Mine.
 - Park in lot.
- Be at the NORCAT Underground Centre/Fecunis Adit Mine on your scheduled day, dressed and ready no later than 7:00 am. Late clients will be charged a non-attendance fee of \$50.00 + HST.**

NORCAT Contractor Orientation

- Upon arrival at the NORCAT Underground Centre, please park in the designated areas.
- Report to the Main Office.
- **Please arrive at site completely dressed in your full PPE.**
- Please have your vehicle license plate ready for documentation.
- Sign the release form and place provided tag on the tag board.
- Await further instructions.
- As training takes 7 hours to complete, please bring a lunch. Leaving the mine site will not be allowed during the training.
- For trainees doing U0012 Lock Out and Tag training only, you must be at the mine site no later than 12:00pm.

The practical training is by appointment only. Please contact the NORCAT office in Sudbury for available booking dates at (705) 521-8324 x 401.

Please note: You have a maximum of 90 days to complete the practical session to successfully complete the training. If you have not completed the training in the prescribed time, the theory training will have to be redone before you can attend the mine site - at an additional cost to you.

Minimum PPE Requirements for Service Type & Tours (Effective July 1st, 2016)

Head Protection

- Hard hat –ANSI approved complete with ear muffs attached and reflective tape placed on hat and muffs.

**PLEASE NOTE:
White hard hats
are absolutely not
allowed.**

Eye Protection

- CSA Z87, Approved Safety glasses, plastic frame, with polycarbonate or equivalent lenses (no glass lenses), complete with side shields. Wire Frame glasses are not permitted.

Foot Protection

- CSA Z195 Grade 1 compliant. Such footwear can be identified by the green triangle bearing the CSA logo.
- Safety footwear shall incorporate electrical shock resistant soles as defined by CSA Z195. This can be identified by the “Ohm” symbol.
- Footwear must be high top, 8 inch minimum, water resistant, steel or composite toe boots complete with internal metatarsal guards.

Hearing Protection

- Double hearing protection must be readily available. Ear plugs will be supplied.

Visibility Apparel

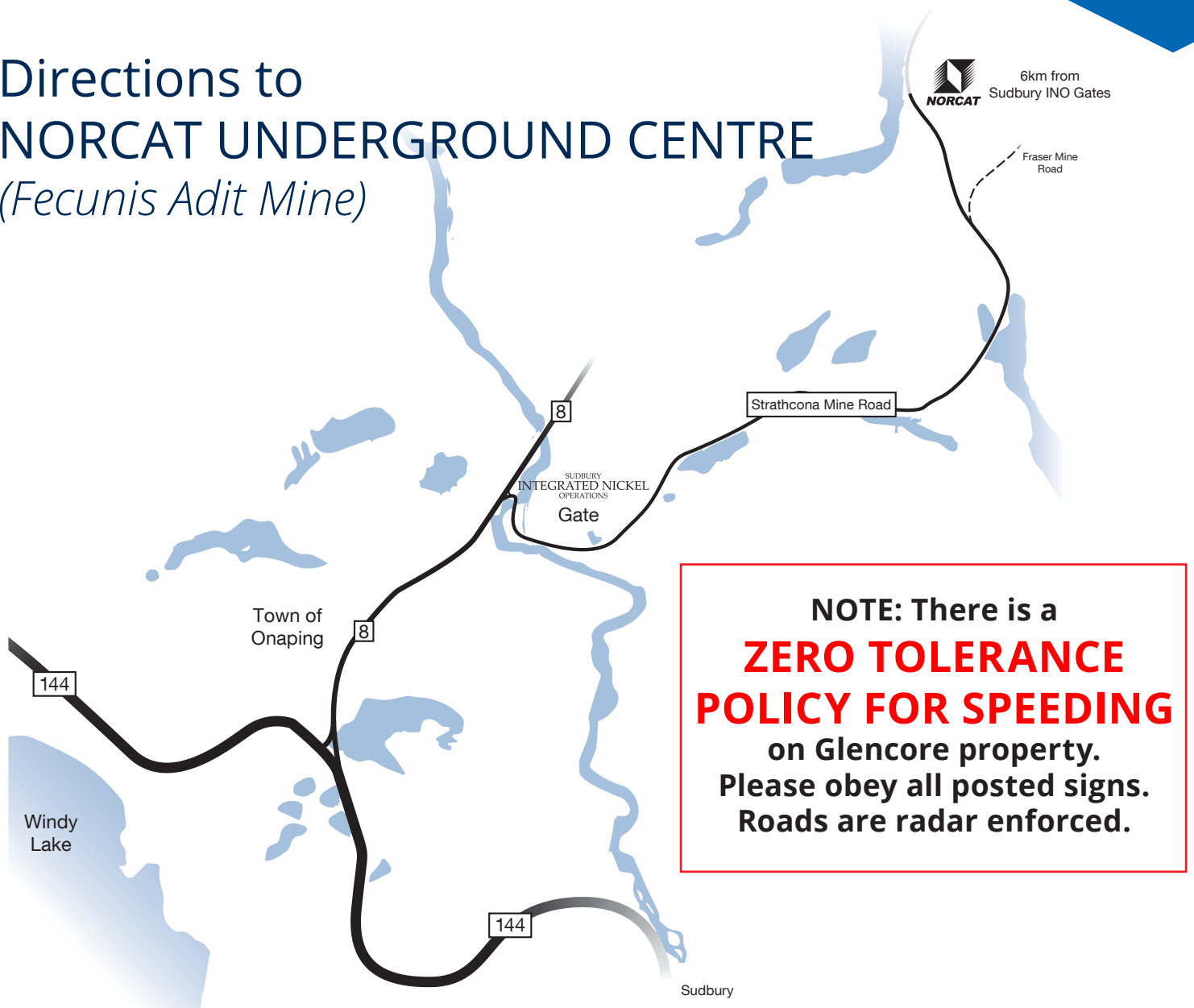
- High visibility safety apparel must be made of fluorescent or bright-coloured background material with 2” (50mm) wide retro-reflective striping.
- Striping on visibility apparel must be arranged:
 - completely encircling the waist, each arm, and each leg below the knee
 - in two vertical lines on the front of the garment, extending from the shoulders down to the waist
 - in an “X” on the back of the garment, extending from the shoulders down to the waist

Hand Protection

- Leather gloves are the minimum standard.

- Take Highway 144 passed Chelmsford and Dowling
